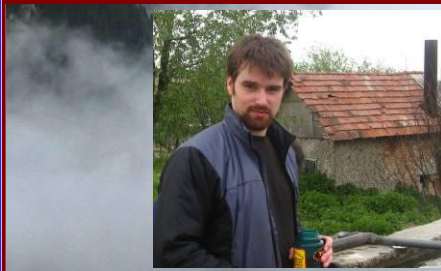
- Brasov Romania, in the middle of Transylvania. Joining the team of the Purtatorii de Facie, Torchbearers International in Romania

- Helping out with the Summer Camps, and pretending to know how to speak a little German.

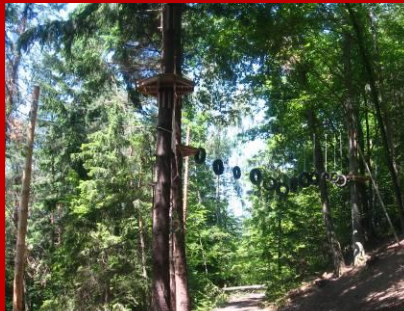


A peek of what God has been teaching me
